**Minimum Qualifications of Bidders**  
**Solicitation**  
**108<sup>th</sup> & 109<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Public Utility Renewal**

Qualification of Bidders:

**Bidders/Contractors must show experience and successful completion of projects with the replacement of potable water, wastewater, stormwater, and roadway improvements within built-out public right-of-ways, or similar projects.**

A. Minimum qualification requirements for General Contractors shall include successful completion of at least 3 similar projects as the 108<sup>th</sup> & 109<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Public Utility Renewal project in the past ten (10) years, within Southwest Florida, for a municipality that included **ALL** the following minimum requirements:

1. Minimum contract value of \$1,500,000.
2. Within a built out residential neighborhood (not a new development).
3. Within a ROW width of 60 feet or less.
4. The installation of a minimum 1 mile of potable water mains (6-inches or larger) and associated water services per each similar project.
5. The installation of a minimum of 1 mile of sanitary sewer mains and associated sewer laterals per each similar project.
6. The installation of a minimum of 1 mile of stormwater piping (15-inches or larger) and associated structures and swales per each similar project.
7. The rebuilding of a minimum 1 mile of roadways per each similar project.

B. The Contractor must provide a matrix with the name of the projects, owner contact information (name, phone number, and email address), year completed, and contract value amount for the projects which meet the minimum qualifications in section A above (3 minimum within the past 10 years). The matrix must include each of these requirements (shown on one axis), and a list of projects (on the other axis). A checkmark (Yes/No) to be used to indicate if the contractor has experience on that minimum requirement for each project listed.

C. Any subcontractors selected by Contractor shall have equivalent experience for the trade in which the work will be performed (exclusive of dollar value noted).

D. Contractor's superintendent and crew(s) must be certified to remove asbestos cement pipe.
