1. What is the allotted Contract time?

Answer: 120-Days to Substantial Completion plus 30-Days to Final Completion for a project total of 150-Days.

2. What are the allotted Liquidated Damages?

Answer: \$1,685.00 per day.

3. Question regarding reference questionnaire , being that past performances are with city/government agencies am I eligible to fill in information on their behalf?

Answer: No. The reference questionnaire states – “This reference must be filled out by the company that has done business with the Bidder/Respondent in the past.”

The term “company” may refer to any other government entity.

4. There is no mention of the time frame for this project.

Answer: The schedule is 120-Days to Substantial Completion plus 30-Days to Final Completion for a project total of 150-Days.

5. There is no warranty nor liquidated damages in the specs.

Answer: Warranty is indicated in the ITB 20. SERVICE AND WARRANTY.
