The following changes, clarifications, additions, and/or deletions are hereby made a part of the Invitation to Bid referenced above, as fully and completely as if the same were fully set forth therein:

1. Bid Closing date is extended until October 16, 2018 @ 2:15 P.M.

2. Is certified payroll required? What is the goal percentage for minority owned subcontractors? Who are the certifying agencies that qualify for minority/woman/small business subcontractors (FDOT DBEs, Hillsborough County WMBEs/SLBEs, City of Tampa WMBEs/SLBEs)?

RESPONSE: As this is a mitigation award Davis Bacon (Certified Payroll) is NOT required for this project. I sent a confirmation from the grant manager when I noticed it was not included in the grant award and was confirmed during our first award and we started on these.

Grants for disaster relief under FEMA's principal relief authority, the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief Act, are not subject to the DBA prevailing wage requirements. FEMA provides grants for disaster assistance including low-interest loans to repair or replace personal property, business disaster loans to fund repair or replacement of real estate, and assistance to state or local governments to pay costs of rebuilding a community's damaged infrastructure.

FEMA has **NO** Minority Percentage Goal in the agreement, the key thing is we solicit per 200.321 of the 2CFR200. Pretty much only FTA and FDOT have percentage goal numbers for participation.

3. Revised Bid Form is attached.

Bidders should acknowledge receipt of this addendum on the Bid Form. Failure to acknowledge receipt of this addendum may be cause for rejection. The opening date will remain unchanged.
